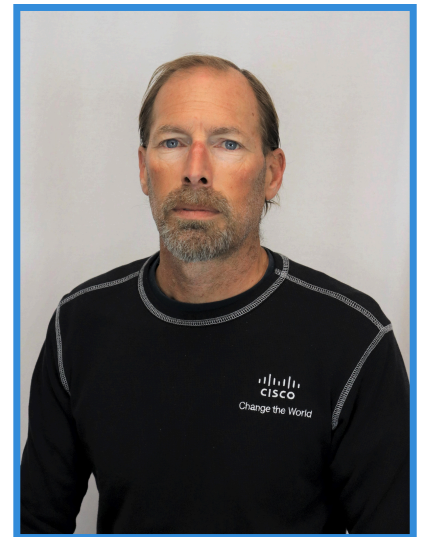
EMPLOYEE SPOTLIGHT
